


Why an LRTP?



Kitsap Transit is Unique


Kitsap Transit operates a range of transit services—both traditional and unique

Ensuring these services are **easy to understand, access, and transfer to and from** is an important long-term goal for the agency




Long-Term Systemwide Trends


While the amount of service provided has increased








DEMAND-RESPONSE SERVICE




Annual ridership has remained relatively stable

Kitsap Transit is committed to reinstating Sunday service over the next few years, contingent upon the hiring of new bus operators.


Evaluating Transit Demand

Population Density


Population densities in Kitsap

Most major activity centers in Kitsap County are in urbanized areas




Activity Centers

Most major activity centers in Kitsap County are in urbanized areas




Overall Transit Demand

Today's transit service largely aligns with places with the highest demand




Where Are People Traveling Today?





Future Growth Patterns


Future multi-family and mixed-use development planned along existing frequent transit corridors



Regional Travel Patterns


