## **RESOLUTION NO. 25-36**

A RESOLUTION OF KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN KITSAP TRANSIT AND AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION (ATU) LOCAL 587

**WHEREAS**, Kitsap Transit staff and ATU Local 587 have reached a tentative collective bargaining agreement for both Routed and *ACCESS* services, which was ratified on April 28, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the tentative agreement for the replacement contract for Routed and *ACCESS* services stipulates a four (4) year term, with a retroactive effective date of February 16, 2024, and ending February 15, 2028; and

**WHEREAS**, wage adjustments for Routed operators and Routed dispatchers will include a five- and one-half percent (5.5%) increase effective February 16, 2024; a four and a quarter percent (4.25%) increase effective February 16, 2025; a three and a quarter percent (3.25%) increase effective February 16, 2026; and a three and three quarter percent (3.75%) increase effective February 16, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, wage adjustments for *ACCESS* operators are greater than Routed operators and Routed dispatch to address disparity between the work groups. *ACCESS* operator wages will receive a six percent (6.0%) increase effective February 16, 2024; a four and three quarter percent (4.75%) increase effective February 16, 2025; a three and three quarter percent (3.75%) increase effective February 16, 2026; and a four and one quarter percent (4.25%) increase effective February 16, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, wage adjustments for each work group will be retroactive for active employees from the date of ratification and on a prorated basis (from February 16, 2024, to their retirement date) for employees who retired between February 16, 2024, and the date of ratification; and

**WHEREAS,** paid holidays for both services will now include Juneteenth as an official holiday; and

WHEREAS, life insurance benefits for each work group will increase from ten

thousand dollars (\$10,000) to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) effective January 1, 2025;

and

WHEREAS, employer contributions for part-time B board employee medical

insurance will increase from fifty percent (50%) to ninety-two and three tenths percent

(92 .3%) and will add dependent coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, dependent coverage for part-time A board employees will increase to

family coverage; and

**WHEREAS,** beginning with the first pay period after February 16, 2026, all full-time

and extra board employees actively employed will receive an additional single allotment

of twenty (20) hours of general leave; and

WHEREAS, upon ratification, employees actively employed in each work group will

receive a one-time two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) ratification bonus.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners hereby

approves the ATU Local 587 Collective Bargaining Agreement for Routed and ACCESS

services, effective February 16, 2024.

**ADOPTED** by the Kitsap Transit Board of Commissioners at a regular meeting held

on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 2025.
